



Introduction

Telling stories is a way to communicate God’s message. Get the Big Picture of the Bible! There's a lot to remember in the Bible and it can be overwhelming, but this event will make bible stories come to life.

Objective

Prepare live representations of stories that teach the principles of our beliefs. This Instaguide event will allow our youth to use their creativity combined with their social media skills to testify and share the gospel with the world. Each team must use a story from the bible and make it come to life. It must be memorable, relevant, and exciting.

Participants

At least 4 representatives or ALL members from each club.

Material

- Individual or club Instagram account (must tag @txyouth)
- 1 Cellphone (At least one club member will need to record the skit while being performed LIVE during the event and upload it to their Instagram account.)
- Props to help bring the story to life.
- Participants dressed in costume to enhance the story.
- Each club can provide special effects like sounds or music if needed.

Procedure

1. Write a skit based on a bible story (Must be an original skit written by a member of the club.)
2. Prepare props and costumes in advance and take them to camporee.
3. Present a copy of the written skit to the judges.
4. Stage props are to be kept to the absolute minimum with **one minute** allowed for setting up.
5. Each team will only be allotted **4 total minutes** to act out the story LIVE in front of the judges and other participants and have 1 club member record the skit and upload it to their Instagram account.
6. Tag @TXYouth when uploading the skit.
7. The skit that receives the most “likes” on Instagram will be awarded with bonus points.
8. The judges will score clubs based on the criteria below.

Points

100 points for participation *BONUS POINTS for team with the most likes on Instagram
