



### **Introduction**

The goal is to create songs to be used for AY programs or events such as camporees, etc.

### **Objective**

Produce a fun, interactive, and catchy AY tune that can be sung at AY events and activities at church, club, or camporee activities. Master guides work closely with our youth. This is a fun and easy strategy you can utilize to assist them with memorizing scripture.

### **Participants**

All club members if possible.

### **Material**

Voices & at least ONE cell phone

### **Procedure**

1. One representative from each club will come to the front and choose a paper with the assigned bible verse.
2. Each club will then have a total of 5 minutes to work as a group to create a song (never published before) and then record themselves performing the song.
3. **The song can only include words from the bible verse. They may use NKJV or Reina Valera 1995 (RVR1995). The only exception to additional words is the club will need to reference the bible verse and translation either at the beginning or end of the song.**
4. An alarm will sound at the end of 5 minutes, instructions on where to upload your song will be projected on the screen. Everyone will be given an additional minute to submit their song.
5. The duration of each song cannot exceed 2 minutes.
6. Submitted songs will then be projected on the screen for all to enjoy and watch.
7. The judges will evaluate each performance while it is being projected. The judges will choose ONE to be performed during the Sabbath evening program.
